RE: Notice of Violation – Failure to Provide Public Notice

Dear Colleen Baker:

Our records indicate that the Sugarite – Lake Alice Campground water system did not provide public notice to your customers **within the required timeframe** for the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued on December 20, 2023. Public Notice was due to customers before 1/19/2024. Sugarite – Lake Alice Campground water system certified that public notice was provided on 2/5/2024.

Pursuant to Section 20.7.10.100 NMAC [incorporating 40 CFR Section 141.203], you were required to notify your customers of the violation by **mail or other direct delivery to each customer** and any other methods as necessary to inform the public, within 30 days from the date on the original NOV.

Because the public notice was provided late to customers, the Sugarite-Lake Alice Campground water system was in violation. Sugarite – Lake Alice Campground water system is not required to take further action concerning this Public Notice NOV.

NMED-DWB reserves the right to take additional enforcement action regarding the violations identified in this NOV, to include the issuance of an Administrative Compliance Order compelling compliance and issuing civil penalties.

Please note that your facility will appear on the Department's Enforcement Watch as a result of this NOV (see: <https://www.env.nm.gov/enforcement-watch/>). Further, the Department will issue a press release to local media highlighting your public water system as appearing on this webpage. Your public water system will remain on the Enforcement Watch website as an active matter until this matter is fully resolved.

Pursuant to the NMED Delegation Order dated February 19, 2024, the Cabinet Secretary has delegated the authority to issue Notice of Violations to DWB Bureau Chief Joe R. Martinez.
