

**NEW MEXICO WATER QUALITY CONTROL COMMISSION NOTICE FOR A PERMIT REVIEW OF DISCHARGE PERMIT RENEWAL AND MODIFICATION, DP-75, NO. WQCC 25-67 (A)**

The New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (“Commission”) will conduct a permit review on Tuesday, March 10, 2026, and continuing on subsequent days, as necessary, via the WebEx video conferencing platform. The purpose of the permit review is to consider the discharge permit renewal and modification, DP-75. The Commission will begin its regular monthly meeting at 9:00 a.m. MDT, and the permit review will begin at the conclusion of its regular business. Information for attending the virtual hearing via the WebEx conferencing platform will be available on the Commission website, <https://www.env.nm.gov/opf/water-quality-control-commission/> and the NMED Event Calendar at least 30 days prior to the hearing.
