Re: Large Entity Reporting Requirement (LERR), 20.2.91.120 NMAC

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) will exercise discretion with the May 1, 2025 compliance requirements for all entities subject to 20.2.91.120 NMAC (Large Entity Reporting Requirement). NMED will exercise discretion for entities that are subject to the May 1, 2025 deadline provided that the entity submits the required report to the NMED Climate Change Bureau through the [Large Entity Reporting Portal](#) by July 31, 2025.

The extension of the compliance date to July 31, 2025 will give fleet owners the opportunity to gather additional information, work with NMED Climate Change Bureau staff, and provide the most complete and accurate information available in their Large Entity Reporting Requirement.

After July 31, 2025, the NMED Climate Change Bureau will determine if any fleet owner failed to respond to this requirement. Those entities that do not respond by July 31, 2025 may be subject to information gathering efforts and/or subject to civil enforcement action.
