Good morning,

I would like to comment in favor of permitting Los Alamos National Laboratory to continue open burning. I am familiar with the work the Laboratory does in training military personnel to identify and deal with improvised explosive devices, and this is extremely valuable work that would be stopped in the absence of an open burning permit.

I understand that those who dislike and distrust the Laboratory are using this permit renewal process to try and hinder the institution's activities. But in this case, they are doing so at the risk of causing the deaths of US military personnel who could otherwise have had essential training here.

Open burning is NOT the problem -- Opponents are fighting LANL's existence as a weapons laboratory -- and they're damaging a valuable, non-nuclear program while objecting to the site's mission and history. Don't let this happen.
