Air Quality Operating Permit
for Trunk L Compressor Station of Harvest Four Corners LLC

Harvest Four Corners LLC at 1755 Arroyo Dr; Bloomfield, NM 87413 has submitted an air quality operating permit application to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for an air quality operating permit for its Trunk L Compressor Station. The owner of this plant is Harvest Four Corners LLC. The exact location of the facility is at latitude and longitude decimal degrees: 36.643275, -107.3552 Datum: NAD83. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 36.5 miles east of Bloomfield in Rio Arriba County, NM. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P166R5 and TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 1037.

Previously, the facility received an air quality construction permit and is in operation.

The main purpose of the facility is to compress and dehydrate pipeline quality natural gas for pipeline transmission using natural gas-fired reciprocating engines.

This operating permit application is for a permit renewal. Per 20.2.70.401.C.(4) NMAC, this permitting action involves incorporating 12 Administrative Revisions for Identical Engine Replacement: 1527M5R7 issued May 25, 2021 for Unit 12; 1527M5R10 issued January 10, 2022 for Unit 11; 1527M5R12 issued October 18, 2022 for Unit 3; 1527M5R14 issued June 23, 2023 for Unit 5; 1527M5R15 issued July 21, 2023 for Unit 2; 1527M5R16 issued September 1, 2023 for Unit 1; 1527M5R17 issued May 9, 2024 for Unit 4; 1527M5R18 issued June 4, 2024 for Unit 7; 1527M5R19 issued October 29, 2024 for Unit 8; 1527M5R20 issued April 8, 2025 for Unit 9; 1527M5R21 issued April 15, 2025 for Unit 6; and 1527M5R22 issued May 1, 2025 for Unit 10.

There are no changes to the existing air emission limits in this permitting action.

The NMED has conducted a preliminary review of the information submitted with the permit application. This review included evaluation of the emission rates and applicable requirements to determine compliance.

The NMED has made a preliminary determination that this facility will comply with the requirements of Title 20, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), Chapter 2, Parts 1, 7, 50, 61, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 77, and 82; 40 CFR 60 Subparts A and JJJJ; 40 CFR 63 Subparts A, HH, and ZZZZ; 40 CFR 64; and the New Mexico Air Quality Control Act. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before April 6, 2026.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.
