



**AT&SF (CLOVIS) SUPERFUND SITE
PUBLIC NOTICE
U.S. EPA Region 6 and
New Mexico Environment Department
August 2022**



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 6 (EPA) and the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) have begun the sixth Five-Year Review of the remedy for the AT&SF (Clovis) Superfund Site, located in Clovis, Curry County, New Mexico.

The remedy for the AT&SF (Clovis) Superfund Site required (1) evaporation of lake water and construction of a dike to prevent surface water run-on; (2) treatment of contaminated soils and sediments to reduce total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) concentrations to below 1,000 parts per million (ppm) or achieve soil stabilization; and (3) excavation and on-site disposal of sediments and soils with a TPH concentration greater than 1,000 ppm.

During the review, EPA and NMED will gather information on the Site and conduct an inspection to make sure the remedy continues to be protective of human health and the environment. EPA and NMED will also conduct interviews with other regulatory authorities, local officials and other pertinent organizations or individuals, including residents, that may be able to provide additional information about the Site's status or condition. Examples of such information that would be important to EPA's determination of protectiveness are:

- Broken fences, unusual odors, materials leaving the Site, or other problems;
- Buildings or land around the Site being used in new ways;
- Any unusual activities at the Site, such as dumping, vandalism, or trespassing; and
- Ways the cleanup at the Site has affected the surrounding community.

The review is scheduled for completion in July of 2023. Upon completion, a sixth Five-Year Review Report will be made available to the public at <https://www.epa.gov/superfund/atsf-clovis> and at the following information repositories:
