Dear Mr. Mathieu:

The New Mexico Environment Department (Department) has reviewed the following for the subject site under Release ID# 4470:

1. Initial Incident Report dated June 28, 2005.
2. Site Inventory records submitted to the Department, May 12, 2006.
3. Line Status Evaluation Report for test date November 29, 2005.

The Department has determined that this site does not pose an immediate threat to public health or the environment based upon the following current site-specific conditions:

1. Contaminants of concern at this site are petroleum hydrocarbon based compounds found in gasoline and diesel.
2. System tests for the petroleum storage tank system at the subject site have passed.
3. Site inventory records for the previous two years account for 99% of the inventory.

Therefore, the Department is not requiring additional work at this time. However, the Department does reserve the right to require additional work in the future, should information become available which indicates that a threat to public health or the environment exists.
