**NOTICE OF INTENT TO PRESENT TECHNICAL TESTIMONY
ON BEHALF OF OXY USA INC.**

Pursuant to 20.1.1.302 NMAC, Oxy USA Inc. (“Oxy USA”) hereby submits this Notice of Intent to Present Technical Testimony on behalf of Oxy USA Inc. for the hearing in this matter currently scheduled for September 20, 2021.

1. Entity for whom the witnesses will testify:

Mr. Danny Holderman will testify for Oxy USA.

2. Names and qualifications of each witness:

Mr. Holderman is the Asset Director for the Onshore Resources and Carbon Management Delaware Basin Business Unit with Oxy USA and has been in this role since October 2018. In this capacity, Mr. Holderman is responsible for oil and gas production operations and related activities carried out on the Company’s assets in the Delaware Basin, and ensuring that those operations and related activities prioritize the health and safety of Oxy USA’s employees, contractors and the surrounding communities; comply with all applicable local, state and federal regulations; and generate value for all stakeholders. Mr. Holderman has been employed with Oxy USA since August 2014. He received a Bachelor of Science degree with honors in Chemical Engineering from Oklahoma State University in May 2004.
