Owners and operators must meet all of the following requirements prior to applying for an extension.

A. Empty the tank and purge the piping of regulated substances so that the tank contains one inch or less or the system contains 0.3 percent by weight or less of the total capacity of the storage tank system of a regulated substance.

B. Perform a site assessment in accordance with 20.5.115.1504 NMAC. (Attach a copy of the laboratory analysis of the soil samples to this request.) If you are requesting to use an alternate method of meeting the requirement for a site assessment, please add a complete description in the comment field on the next page.

C. Pay all annual tank fees and all accrued late fees for all tanks they own or operate in accordance with 20.5.103 NMAC.

D. Meet financial responsibility requirements in 20.5.117 NMAC. (Attach a copy of the mechanism used to meet this requirement to this request.)

Owners and Operators of storage tank systems that do not meet the requirements in #4 above shall ensure the storage tank systems are permanently closed pursuant to 20.5.115.1502 NMAC.
