### **PUBLIC NOTICE OF STAGE 2 ABATEMENT PLAN PROPOSAL**

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (NMWQCC) Regulations, Section 20.6.2.4108 NMAC, that a Stage 2 Abatement Plan proposal has been submitted to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) for the Laun-Dry Supply Company (Laun-Dry), located at 1503 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Albuquerque, New Mexico. The Abatement Plan proposes treatment of ground water containing tetrachloroethene (PCE) (drycleaning product) and trichloroethene (TCE) (byproduct of PCE degradation), in excess of the NMWQCC standards. This contamination is found in the groundwater beneath and beyond the Laun-Dry boundaries as a result of past releases. On April 29, 2016, NMED notified Laun-Dry that it required a Stage 2 Abatement Plan.

The purpose of a Stage 2 Abatement Plan is to select and design an abatement option that, when implemented, will result in attainment of ground water standards. The submitted Stage 2 Abatement Plan proposal consists of: 1) permeable reactive barriers (PRB), emplaced via injection of microbes, fluids, or slurries to treat and/or sequester the contamination, 2) long term monitoring, 3) monitored natural attenuation of the groundwater plumes, and 4) institutional control in the form of an Office of the State Engineer order to prohibit new wells from being installed in the Abatement Plan Area.

The Secretary of the NMED will accept written comments on the proposed plan, and requests for a public meeting or hearing that include reasons why a public meeting or hearing should be held, if submitted **no later than November 3, 2016**. A public meeting or hearing will be held if the Secretary determines there is significant public interest. The Secretary will consider the information contained in the proposed plan, written comments timely received, and information submitted at a public meeting or hearing, if held, in making a final determination on whether to approve the proposed plan or to notify the responsible party of the plan's deficiencies.
